BASKETBALL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. National Federation rules shall be followed unless superseded by NJSIAA rules or Conference policies.
2. If a game has to be rescheduled, every attempt should be made to reschedule prior to county tournaments and by mutual consent.
3. Varsity, J.V. and Freshman games will be played at the same site. (Unless special circumstances arise).
4. The home school will determine starting times. Recommended times are as followed:
 1. Afternoon Games
 - Frosh 4:00 P.M.
 - J.V. 5:15 P.M.
 - Varsity 4:00 P.M.
 2. Night Games
 - Frosh 4:00 P.M.
 - J.V. 5:15 P.M.
 - Varsity 7:00 P.M.
 3. Saturday Games
 - Frosh 10:00 A.M.
 - J.V. 11:30 A.M.
 - Varsity 1:00 P.M.
5. Girls Basketball will be played on the same days or nights at opposite sites of the boys games.
6. No official should purposely be hired to officiate both the JV and Varsity games on the same date.
7. The home team is responsible for both the scorebook and clock. (A responsible adult shall operate the clock for Varsity games).
8. The official conference basketballs shall be Federation Approved.
9. All Division selections shall consist of 1st and 2nd team. Five players and 3 open positions will be selected for both 1st team and 2nd team. There shall also be an Honorable Mention team with one selection per school.
10. Division championship shall be determined by two (2) points for a win.

11. Basketball Warm up Period

All first games shall start at 4:00 P.M. (day) and 5:15 P.M. (evening) as long as the visiting team arrives twenty-five minutes prior to game time. If the visiting team arrives less than twenty-five minutes before 4:00 P.M. or 5:15 P.M., the game shall start twenty-five minutes after the visiting team enters the gymnasium. The following game shall start fifteen minutes after the conclusion of the first game.

12. All warm-up period timing will be conducted on the scoreboard clock.
13. The home team will provide ice, water and basketballs for the visiting team.
