Softball Rules and Regulations

- 1. Federation Rules with NJSIAA modifications will govern play.
- 2. Divisional Championships will be determined by two (2) points for a win and (1) point for a tie. Only Divisional games count toward Divisional championship.
- 3. Only NFHS/NJSIAA approved balls may be used.
- 4. All games are to start at 4:15 p.m. unless mutually agreed on in advance.
- 5. On the sub-varsity level, there will be a two hour curfew on games. If the sub-varsity game starts at 4:15 PM, no inning will start after 6:15 PM. If a school or field has a curfew rule because of field use, that rule will take precedence over the Big North curfew rule for sub-varsity games.
- 6. Sub Varsity games will be played at the same site with Varsity opposite, unless mutually agreed upon.
- All Varsity Divisional games must be assigned by The Big North Conference hired assignor. Only NJSIAA certified officials shall officiate varsity games.
- 8. Teams shall have a maximum of 10 minute infield/outfield warm up period. If the bus is late, the game will start 25 minutes after arrival.
- 9. All Divisional selection shall consist of a first and second Team, with two honorable mention selections per school. The first and second teams will consist of: 1 first base, 1 catcher, 2 pitchers, 3 infielders, 3 outfielders and 4 open positions, which will be designated to the position of the highest vote earner in each spot for a total of 14. For Divisions of 7 teams, 1st and 2nd teams will consist of 15 athletes. For Divisions of 8 teams, 1st and 2nd teams will consist of 16 athletes.
- 10. Postponed games should be made up on the next available date.
- 11. Only players, managers and coaches are permitted to occupy the bench area. Coaches on the lines must be in shirts or jackets of the school colors.
